Position Description: the Community Learning Coordinator is responsible for the implementation of Healthy Relationships, a group-level intervention for HIV-positive individuals. This position is also responsible for planning and implementing an educational series for all LCS clients. This position works with a co-facilitator for Healthy Relationships, collaborates with Medical Case Managers and is supervised by the Deputy Director

Essential Functions: Key activities of the Community Learning Coordinator include, but may not be limited to:

- Convene and facilitate Local Advisory Group;
- Conduct group-level interventions for target population;
- Provide assessment and referral for target population to more intensive services;
- Participate in training and orientation required for effective program implementation;
- Perform any other department or agency-related duties or special projects as directed by supervisor.

Education and Requirements:

- Master's degree in Public Health, Social Work or related field and/or professional certification in counseling required
- Experience working with HIV-positive individuals
- Knowledge of HIV/AIDS and substance abuse and its impact on minority health issues
- Ability to develop rapport and positive relationships with at-risk and hard-to-reach populations including HIV+ individuals and substance abusers. Ability to make decisions according to defined protocols
- Ability to work with multi-disciplinary approach
- Must be bilingual (English and Spanish) with excellent Spanish and English verbal/written communications skills and cultural competence in client and community values and behaviors
- Available to work some evenings and weekends
- Some in-state and out-of-state travel required
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
