Comprehensive Risk Counseling & Services (CRCS) Counselor – Part Time (17.5 hours/week) Care & Supportive Services

Salary Range: \$22.00 - \$24.75/hour

Position Description: Comprehensive Risk Counseling & Services (CRCS) is designed to provide intensive, individualized client-centered counseling for adopting and maintaining HIV risk-reduction behaviors. CRCS counselors will work with HIV-positive clients to develop an individualized prevention plan with goals and measurable objectives.

Essential Functions: Key activities of the CRCS counselor include, but may not be limited to:

- Effectively manage a caseload of 8-15 clients
- Complete a comprehensive assessment of client needs
- Develop an individualized prevention plan, including specific steps taken to meet the identified needs
- Monitor and evaluate continued appropriateness of plan
- Make all appropriate referrals, both within LCS and to other organizations
- Develop, maintain, and continually update a resource file to address client needs
- Help client maintain and develop linkages with community resources
- Advocate as necessary to help client obtain needed services
- Maintain required documentation and data management duties
- Maintain confidentiality of all client-related information
- Other duties as assigned
- Meet with clinical supervisor as required.

Education and Requirements:

- Graduate degree and/or licensure in counseling or other human services field required
- Experience working with HIV-positive individuals required
- Knowledge of local care and community resources network preferred
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Bilingual (Spanish/English) required
- Available to work some evenings and weekends
- Valid CT driver's license and reliable personal transportation
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
